I, Jane Smith, declare as follows:

1. I am the Petitioner in the above-captioned matter.
2. The preceding 2 pages contain true and accurate copies of 19 text messages exported from Jane Smith's phone, WhatsApp chat with John Smith.
3. The messages were exported using WhatsApp built-in 'Export Chat' feature, without media on or about June 18, 2026, producing the file "Sample WhatsApp Chat (fictional).txt" (1,586 bytes).
4. The SHA-256 cryptographic hash of that file is: 615355b7937377a0d0c970222b119133d251fe5ceb2dd41745c325cdb2093f9f. This hash was computed at the time of exhibit preparation and can be used to verify that the source file has not been altered since.
5. Portions of 1 message, comprising 1 redaction, have been removed and are marked "[REDACTED]". No other alterations were made to message content.
6. I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
